Winter Scores Competition All Days October 2024 - March 2025

A <u>FREE</u> to enter U3A Pétanque members competition running concurrently as 3 separate competitions for the Monday, Tuesday and Thursday sessions.

The session is arranged as normal and all you do is enter (or get entered) each of your game results (not the actual score) on the sheet provided. Everyone is entered by default

Entry is **FREE** so you have nothing to lose only prizes to gain.

The weekly scores competition will run from Monday 28th, Tuesday 29th & Thursday 31st October until 16th, 17th & 19th December for a Christmas and New Year break then re-starting in the New Year on Monday 6th, Tuesday 7th & Thursday 9th January and finishing on Monday 24th, Tuesday 25th, & Thursday 27th March and this gives 20 weeks for the competition so the more often you turn up to play the better your chances of winning.

Before entering the results on the sheet check the result with your opponents.

Each time you turn up for a session you will be given 1 point for each game you play irrespective of whether you win, lose or draw the game.

You will receive 0 extra points for a game loss (making a total of 1 point)

You will receive 2 extra points for a game draw (making a total of 3 points)

You will receive 3 extra points for a game win (making a total of 4 points)

You will receive 4 extra points for a game you win 13-X (making a total of 5 points)

So, if you turn up and play 3 games and lose all 3 games you still get 3 points.

Likewise, if you turn up and play only 2 games and win 1 game 13-X and draw the other game you will get 8 points.

A minimum number of 6 players per session to enable points to be awarded.

There will be prizes for the top 3 Players on each of the days at the end of the competition.

If the points are equal between players, then the person who played fewer games to gain the points takes the higher position.

Prizes will be presented at the earliest opportunity after the last round has been played.

It is up to you to enter or ensure someone enters the Win by 13 (W13), Win (W), Draw (D) or Loss (L) on the sheet provided. If there is no sheet available then that week is void for everyone.

The weekly leader board will be available as a printed copy on each playing day to view and available to view by anyone on the Cirencester Pétanque website (below) and click / touch the "Current Leader Board" button for the day you want to look at.
